Abstract Submission

Submitted abstracts should contain the following information:

- title of your presentation
- descriptive abstract of your project presentation (no more than 400 words, with up to one additional page of references or figures).

Abstract review will be a double-blind review process.

For this reason, your abstract should not include your name or any other identifying information.

Final decisions will be communicated by January 29th, 2025.

Abstracts may be submitted after the January 12th deadline; however, late abstracts will not be reviewed blind.

Traditional Presentations (15-minute presentation + 5-minute Q&A)

• may be project proposals or completed projects

Poster Presentations

- may be project proposals or completed projects
- posters will be presented digitally. You do not need to print a poster for this conference.
